Minimum ICT security measures for public administrations.

The minimum ICT security measures issued by AgID aim at countering the most frequent cyber threats to the Italian public administration.

As of 31 December 2017, the percentage of PAs that have aligned themselves with the required measures can be verified on the dedicated dashboard.

What do the security measures consist in?

The measures consist in technological, organisational and procedural controls.

Depending on the complexity of the information system to which they refer and the organizational reality of the Administration, the minimum measures can be implemented gradually following three levels of implementation.

Minimum: it is that to which every Public Administration, regardless of its nature and size, must necessarily be or conform to.

Standard: it is the level, above the minimum level, that each administration must consider as a reference basis in terms of security and represents most of the realities of the Italian PA.

Advanced: it must be adopted by the organizations most exposed to risks (for example due to the criticality of the information processed or the services provided), but also seen as an objective of improvement by all the other organizations.
